#### **OLA 2014-2015 Family Referral Program**

Would you turn down \$500? How about \$1,000, or more? With very little effort, that choice can be yours. OLA offers a \$500 Tuition Credit to current families for each <u>new</u> student ("Prospective Student") who is referred to, and enrolls in, OLA School for the 2014-2015 year. Certain conditions must be satisfied in order for the Tuition Credit to be effective. These are more fully described in the program outline below:

# Program Requirements of Referring and/or Prospective Families

### Step One – Activation of Potential Tuition Credit:

- The Prospective Family must identify the Referring Family <u>at the time of application on the application form,</u> and
- The Referring Family must complete a Tuition Credit Referral Form in the OLA School Office.

### Step Two – Admission and Enrollment:

- The Prospective Student must qualify for admission, apply, be accepted, and enroll in OLA for the 2014-2015 school year.
- The Referring Family must have children enrolled at OLA at the time of referral.

#### Step Three - Tuition Credit

- The Tuition Credit is effective upon a) Prospective Student's completion of (3) months of continuous enrollment and b) Prospective Family's status of "Good Standing" on its tuition payment schedule.
- The \$500 Tuition Credit is applied to the Referring Family's tuition in the same school year in which the Prospective Student is first enrolled.
- If Referring Family tuition is already paid-in-full, a check for \$500 will be issued and mailed to the Referring Family.

## Other Important Program Features:

- A Referring Family is eligible for a \$500 tuition credit for <u>each</u> Prospective Student who enrolls at OLA for the 2014-2015 school year and satisfies the conditions under Step Three, above. The Tuition Credit is <u>not</u> based on how many children the Referring Family has enrolled. [For example, if the Smiths, who have 3 attending students, are responsible for referring the Johnsons, who enroll 1 student, the Tuition Credit is \$500 for the Smith family. If the Smiths refer the Jones who enroll 2 children, the Smith family will receive a \$1,000 Tuition Credit.]
- Prospective Family is defined as a student or family that has no other immediate family members (siblings) enrolled at OLA at the time of referral.
- This offer is subject to enrollment restrictions. For example, the class size must be able to accommodate the new student(s) being referred.
- OLA teachers, administrators and staff who refer students to the school are eligible to participate in the program. These payments will be in the form of cash compensation.
